DECEMBER FOOD DRIVE A SUCCESS; OVER 20 PEOPLE FED



Unitary America held its second food drive with its Feed America program on December 13th, at the Plattsburgh Public Library, feeding over 20 people. Donations collected from local businesses totaled over 400 pounds - including hundreds of cans of soups, vegetables, pastas, and sauces. Turnout for the event was modest, although still managed to feed a large amount of community members. Unitary America, due to the performance of its second drive, is holding a second food drive on February 14, between 11:00-2:00, at the Plattsburgh Public Library. Unitary America is aiming to feed another twenty to fifty people with its next food drive. Boxes have been set up at participating businesses.
