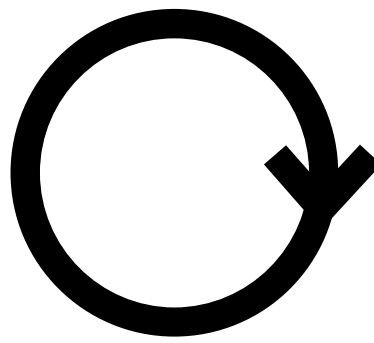




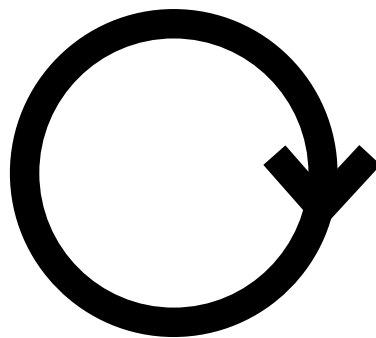

UNITARY AMERICA FEEDS OVER SEVENTY IN TWO WEEKS

Unitary America, between July 25 and July 31 fed over seventy North Country residents, as part of its expanding outreach efforts. Unitary America distributed fresh -baked bread and pastries donated from local, family-owned bakeries, and from distributors in the Plattsburgh area. These bread drives occurred at the Plattsburgh Public Library, the chief venue for all of Unitary America's events. Unitary America will continue to scale up the frequency

of its events throughout the remainder of the calendar year. Bread is available free of charge to any person, regardless of income. "Unitary America has always believed in removing barriers, and making our programs as accessible as possible. If you need the bread, if you need the food, then we have it at our events," Unitary America's Leader, Garrett Monette, added. Unitary America, since its first food giveaway in November 2025, has fed over three-hundred households. "Let's feed Plattsburgh, and leave no one left behind," stated Garrett Monette.

UNITARY AMERICA GROWS TREMENDOUSLY; OVER 330 SUPPORTERS

Unitary America, led by its Leader Garrett Monette, has announced its rapid expansion to over 330 supporters, tripling in size since the beginning of April. Unitary America only had less than ten in early November. “This growth is unlike anything we’ve ever seen. It’s due to the tangible, on-the-ground action we do every day, every week, and every month. We put our communities first, and leave no resident behind.” In light of these recent developments, Unitary

America is aiming to expand its current programs. “We have a lot in the works. New programs, new benefits, and new initiatives. I can’t thank our supporters enough,” says Garrett Monette, Leader of Unitary America. “We need all those willing to help their communities. We need do-ers, people that want to get things done.” Unitary America is projecting continued compounding supporter growth, and is expecting to eclipse four-hundred supporters in August, and at least seven-hundred by the end of the year.

Unitary America, in collaboration with the Plattsburgh Pulse, is preparing to launch the



Plattsburgh Passport, an initiative designed to increase downtown food traffic, support small business, and drive economic development throughout the Plattsburgh area. Garrett Monette, Leader of Unitary America, states that “this is what we need to create community, to create a stronger local economy. Small business is the lifeblood of Plattsburgh, the lifeblood of our community.” Unitary America collaborated on the idea with Plattsburgh Pulse, a local community-focused agency. Any questions regarding the Plattsburgh Passport should be directed there. “Unitary America is very proud to support initiatives like this,” stated Garrett Monette. “Community is what matters. Community, unity, action.” Unitary America is devising, in the upcoming months, other ways to help aid its communities, and help encourage small business foot traffic. “We’re always looking for ways to help our community. Ways to make life more affordable, and ways to build a better community,” added Monette.

OTHER ORGANIZATIONAL UPDATES

BY UNITARY AMERICA EDITORS

- Permitting those under eighteen years old, but no younger than fourteen, to join and volunteer for Unitary America, assuming that the proper Parental Consent Form is completed at unitaryamerica.org/membership.
- Continued work on chapter creation outside of the Plattsburgh area.
- Improving financial reporting and financial accountability protocols
- Distributing Membership Cards to all supporters of Unitary America, including a one-month mandate to distribute all Membership Cards mailed before May 1, 2026 before August 31, 2026. All other Membership Cards will be printed and distributed by September 10, 2026.
- Continuing recruitment
- Identifying community engagement opportunities, and developing a separate calendar for tabling (at farmer's markets, artisan markets, etc.).
- Developing and implementing a new social media strategy to direct traffic to Unitary America's website, and spreading awareness about Unitary America's mission.
- Simplifying website information, removing outdated terminology/ information.
- Cleaning and maintaining the South Acres Community Garden.
- Launching initial preparations for Unitary America's first Fall Festival in September.
- Continuing to expand and develop business partnerships.

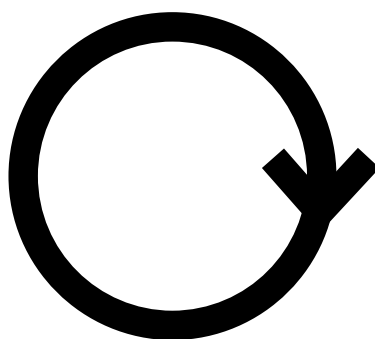
